Arlington Ridge Rd/23rd St/Meade St Reconstruction Project to Start Week of Aug 8, 2011

County to Reconstruct Ridge Road Intersections with S. 23rd, Oakcrest, and Meade Streets beginning August 8, 2011

County reconfiguration of the intersection of So. Arlington Ridge Road, So. 23rd, Oakcrest and Meade Streets is scheduled to begin August 8th and take approximately 4 weeks. After two meetings on May 5th and May 19th, where area residents voiced many concerns, ARCA sent a letter requesting a hold on the redesign until neighbor concerns could be addressed. The June 29th County response contained some changes to the prior plan, but retained the redesign of S. Meade Street (a major concern of immediate neighbors). Subsequent meeting with Ms. Hynes on July 6 resulted in no additional changes. Traffic calming projects for Ridge Road and surrounding side streets have been a major issue for ARCA for the past several years. Updates on plans and progress have been provided periodically via email, the ARCA web site and association newsletters. Results from the recent Neighborhood Conservation Plan (NCP) survey identified traffic calming as one of the primary issues of concern.
