#### **UPDATE ON THE JOINT ANP PROJECT AT FT. SCOTT/GROVE ST**

ARCA and AHCA proposed a joint project to the Arlington Neighborhood Program to improve pedestrian safety at the Fort Scott Dr/Grove St intersection. The program requires at least 69% of affected homeowners to sign on in support of the project for it to advance to the funding round. Despite repeated efforts to reach homeowners and explain the importance of the project, we did not reach the necessary threshold and therefore, the project has stalled. ### ARMY NAVY DRIVE BIKE LANE PROTECTED BIKE LANE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Starting the week of November 10, crews will begin preparations for construction\_between South Joyce Street and Memorial Drive.

In the first weeks of work, crews will be installing tree protection which will be in place for the duration of construction, demolishing the center median at the South Joyce Street intersection, as well as manhole work and other work within the road.

During this time, the lanes closest to the median will close on Army Navy Drive between South Joyce Street and South Lynn Street. Car traffic will shift to the outer lanes. The northbound bike lane will be closed, and bicyclists will share the car lane.

This project will add a two-way protected cycle track on Army Navy Drive between South Joyce Street and Memorial Drive. The bike facility will connect with the new cycle tracks built as part of the Army Navy Drive Complete Streets project between South Joyce Street and 12th Street South.
